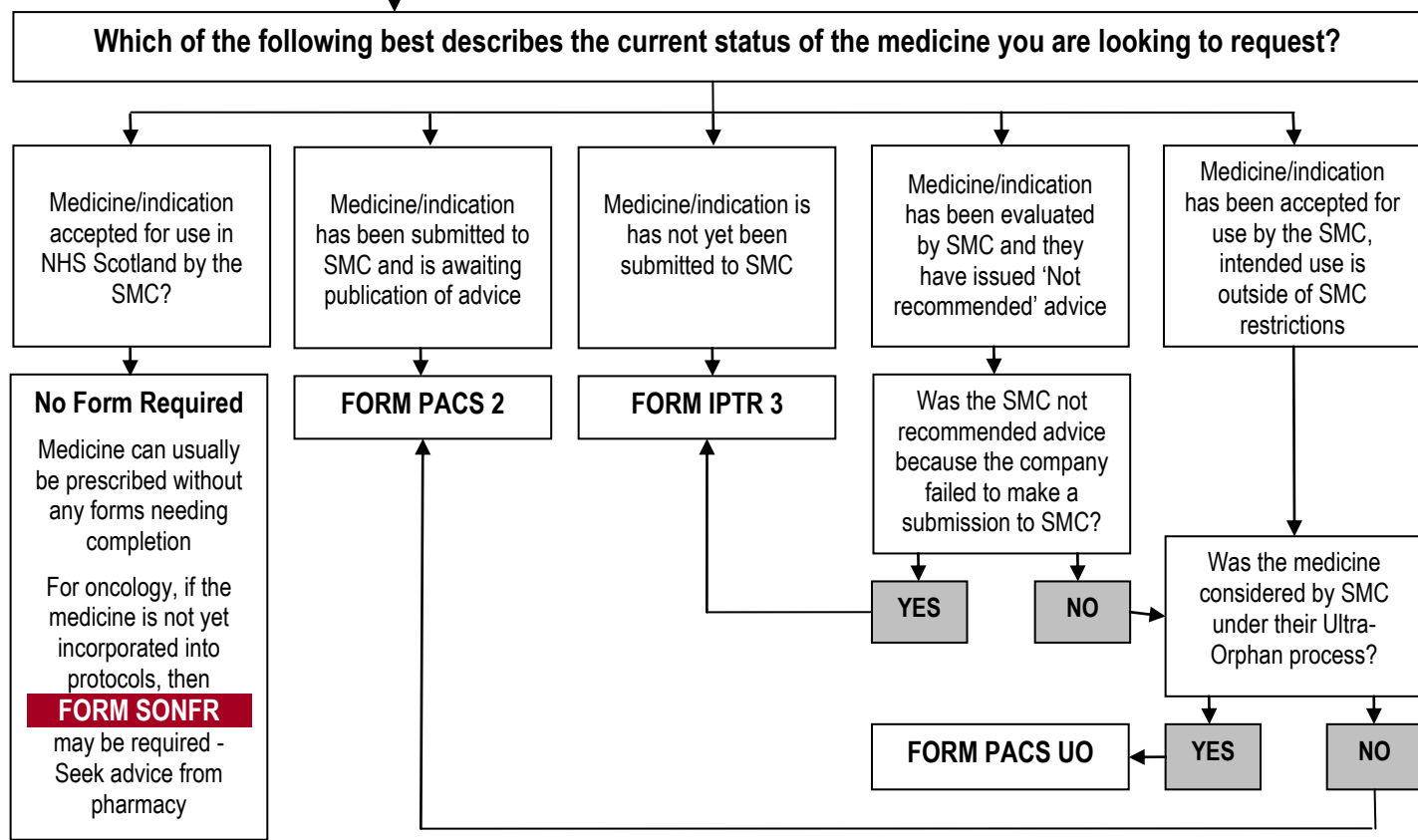
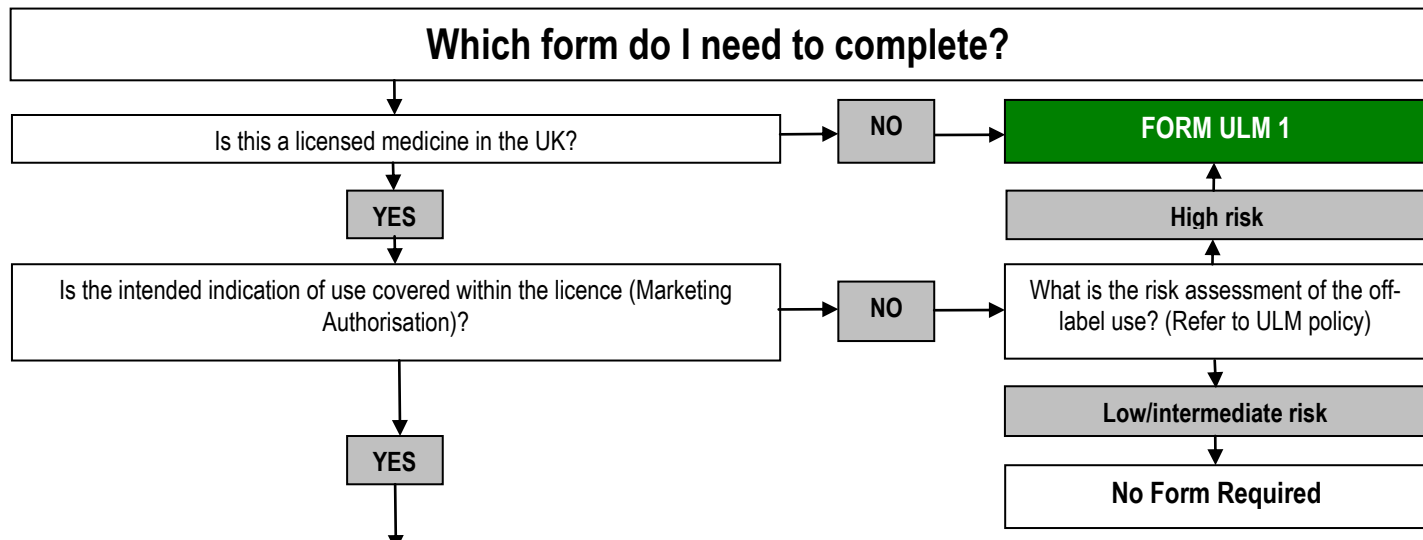


WHICH FORM DO I NEED TO COMPLETE?

- The process for accessing medicines differs dependent on the type of request.
- There are generally five types of request: Peer Approved Clinical System Tier 1 (PACS UO), Peer Approved Clinical System Tier 2 (PACS 2), Individual Patient Treatment Request (IPTR), Unlicensed Medicine Request (ULM) or Specialist Oncology Non-Formulary Request
- Use the following flowchart to determine whether any documentation is required and if so, which is the correct form to complete
- Completing the incorrect form may result in delay, so it is essential you follow the correct process first time
- If after using this flowchart, you are still unsure of which form to use, seek advice from Pharmacy or Medicines Information.
