Current drug shortages

There are currently a number of UK wide drug shortages some with increases in cost. Below is a table of those drugs which are likely to have highest impact. The table details the drugs and the specific preparations which are affected and provides information about the estimated timescale for availability and potential cost impact. It should also be recognised a return to normal stock levels may take a week or so from the date manufacturer or wholesaler states the medicine is now available.
